What is safeguarding?

Keeping you safe and healthy at school and at home
Making sure that you feel safe in your environment and are protected from harm from both adults and other young people
Educating you to know how to keep yourself safe

Who is available to help?

At school you can talk to:

- Your Personal Tutor/Progress Leader/Trusted Teacher/Learning Mentor
- The Safeguarding Team
- PC Tetlow
- The School Nurse

Outside of school you can talk to:

- Trusted Family Members or Friends
- Your Family Doctor
- Kooth/CAMHs
- Addaction
- The Police

Where can I go?

In school you can go to:

- The Mentor Room
- The Safeguarding Office
- A Classroom Teacher
- School Nurse drop ins

Outside of school:

- The School website
- Online Support websites
- CAHMs drop in - Friday 2.30 - 4.30 at Kingsway Library

When can I speak to someone?

- You or a family member can talk to a member of staff at anytime about a worry or a concern that you may have about yourself or a friend
- You can also report concerns anonymously through the SHARP system via the school website

Why is it important?

There are lots of risks to young people from both adults and other young people. From time to time, children can suffer abuse. This can be physically, sexually or emotionally hurtful and can happen in person or online. It could also mean that a child's needs are being neglected by someone who should care for them. We want to make sure that everyone at WDHS is protected from abuse and harm.

How will you keep me safe?

- All WDHS staff are trained in how to keep you safe
- We will always listen and act upon your concerns. This may involve working with your parents or carers or getting help from other services outside of school
- Your wishes and feelings will always be considered
