

Helping your child to revise effectively

Effective Revision:

- Carefully planned and structured
- Focused on areas of weakness
- Starts well in advance of exams
- Active and varied
- · Reduces info to key points
- Frequent but 'chunked'
- Collaborative and social

Ineffective Revision:

- Ad hoc and unstructured
- Ignores key weaknesses
- Passive and repetitive
- Does not involve 'transformation'
- Long periods without a break (or not enough time to engage fully)
- Done in isolation







Period 6 Support
