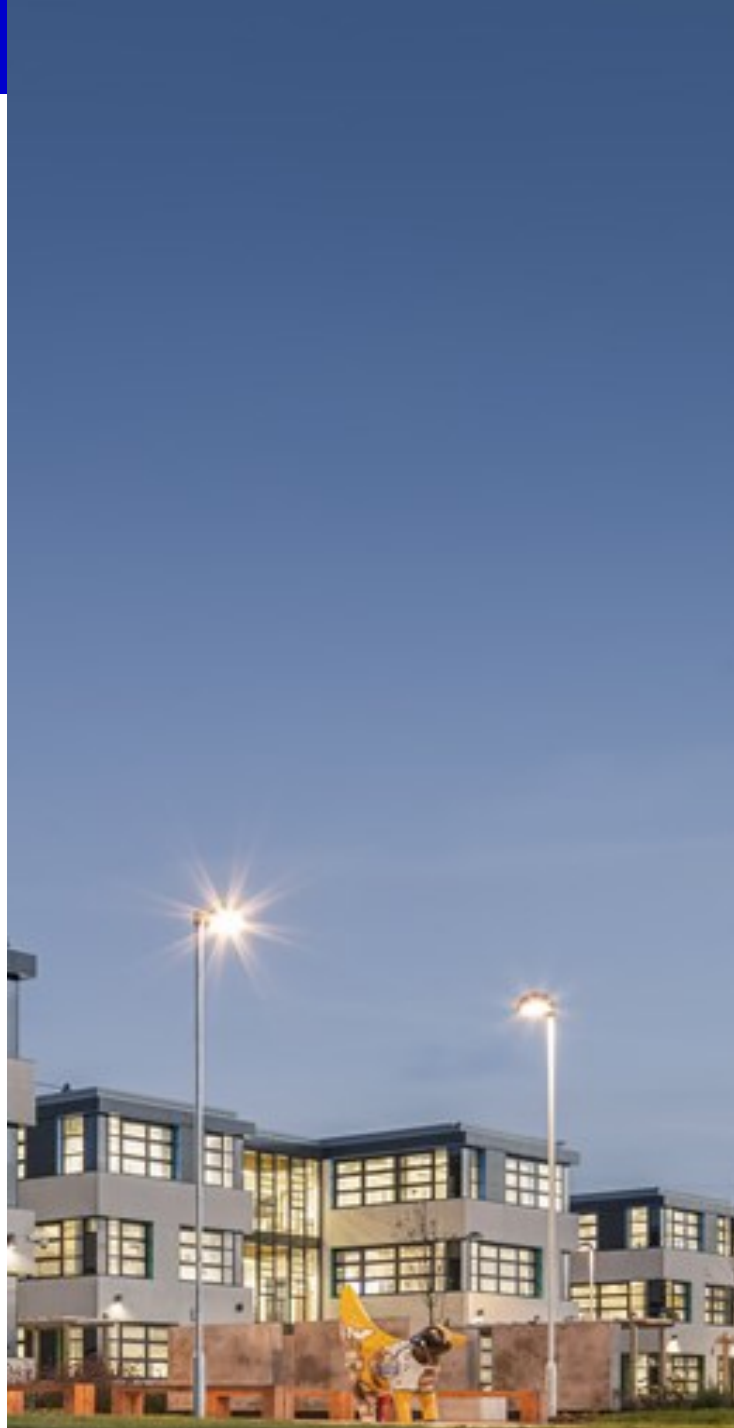

Triple P

Triple P is an evidence based parenting course designed to support every parent to enable them to develop the skills, knowledge and confidence to parent in a way that supports their family and values. It focuses around building positive relationships and assertive discipline in a non-aggressive manner.

The course is offered in small groups, or individually, over 4 weekly instalments of 2 hours each.

Positive Parenting Seminars

Positive Parenting sessions are a series of 3 seminars, each lasting for 45 minutes, that are devised to support your parenting and make you feel more connected to school.

Come along to one or all three. Seminars take place twice a year.
